## GENERAL RULES

- 1. **ETHICS:** *The Urban Scholar Science & Engineering Scholar Fair* is a project/event of Urban Scholar Athletes, a Project of Community Partners. All students are expected to create, with the assistance of an adult, a science or engineering project that reflects his/her own creativity, scientific thought process; and exhibits thoroughness and clarity.
- 2. **APPLICATION:** Contestant applications, including the media release form and abstract, must be completed prior to participation and can be downloaded in the "overview" section of the website. All applications, and supporting materials, must be completed by Friday, March 25, 2016 by 5 p.m. No exceptions.
- 3. **RESTRICTIONS:** All projects must be done in a school, home, or field. No projects will be admitted for work done in a research institution. Additionally, no experiment regarding chemically explosive materials will be admitted.
- 4. **DISPLAY:** All project display boards must adhere to the science & engineering fair criteria mentioned in the "criteria & judging section" of the event website.
- 5. **ABSTRACT:** All projects must be accompanied by an "abstract" form, which includes an overview of the project title, purpose, hypothesis, brief statement about procedures/equipment, results, and conclusion. Visit the website to download the "abstract" form.
